Mason County Public Health Officer:

Dr. Gushee and I had the opportunity to meet with the new Mason County Public Health Officer, Dr. Keri Gardner. She displayed great energy and enthusiasm for improving population health and will be a good partner for Mason Health going forward.

We held a fact-finding meeting of interested stakeholders to look into relocating the Women’s Clinic into Mason Clinic by the end of this year. The overall opinion is to accomplish this in mid-December. We shared this information with the Clinic Providers and Staff so they are on board and will be ready for this move as well. There are financial benefits to getting this done before 2022, however this could be put on further hold should COVID transmissions increase, necessitating the need for further and continued social distancing.

Transition of Providers in the Walk In Clinic was mentioned last month. We had two Providers resign – one leaving in October, the other in December. Fortunately, we have filled each of these openings, with both new Providers starting in November. Through our recruiting efforts we have also been able to increase our stable of per diem Providers, who will be available to cover vacations or other open shifts.
