MASKING UPDATES

- Patients and visitors with respiratory symptoms (i.e. sneezing, coughing, runny nose, etc.) are required to wear masks to protect others. Well-fitted masks are effective in protecting patients and caregivers from catching and spreading respiratory illnesses.
- Staff experiencing respiratory symptoms will be required to mask at all times except in areas where they are alone.
- All staff members will be required to mask when facing patients, unless behind a plexiglass barrier.
- Masks will be available for those individuals who would like to continue masking, and masks will be available in all clinical and non-clinical locations without discrimination.
