


# Volunteer Workforce Culinary & Nutrition Services Update

- A new CNS Grab & Go Market will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. near the Lower Level Clinic Breakroom (see page 2).


### Mason Health Cafeteria (Bistro)

## Move Notice Pro-Tips for Mason Clinic Breakroom Employee Food Service:


- Beginning 3/24/25 Breakroom 20-410, located in Clinic/Lower Level, will be unavailable.
